Dress Code

This dress code applies at school, school trips, and all school sponsored events.

Early Childhood Center Attire

We strongly encourage children to be dressed in clothing that is washable, comfortable and appropriate for Early Childhood activities. We believe in a hands-on learning approach, and although most of the materials we use are washable, we cannot guarantee that your children's clothing will not stain. School provides a smock for each child. Shoes should be comfortable, and appropriate for all outdoor activities including running and climbing. Please do not send your child in loose shoes (no crocs).

Uniforms - K-8

All students from Kindergarten through 8th grade are required to wear school uniforms.

LHA administration reserves the right to determine appropriateness of student appearance and will determine the acceptability of adornments. Students are expected to arrive at school daily clean and well-groomed. Parents will be notified if a child is not properly attired in uniform and will be asked to bring a change of clothes or will be provided and billed from the front office.

All Students

- **Sweaters/Sweatshirts:** solid color sweaters only. [No words, designs, pictures, or logos, including camps, & Bar/Bas mitzvahs]. No denim jackets allowed. *Chidon and 8th Grade school sweaters are the only exception*.
- Caps: Caps and hoods are allowed only during recess/PE.
- Backpacks & Lunch Boxes: No pop culture designs or characters.

Girls' Dress Code

- **Kindergarten-Grade 2:** Navy blue jumpers (monogrammed) and uniform color (white, pink, light blue, navy) long sleeved polo shirt (monogram not needed).
- Grades 3 8: navy blue pleated skirts and monogrammed uniform long sleeved polo shirt. Only the top button may be open.
- All skirts and jumpers must fully cover the knee while sitting and standing.
- Legs must be fully covered at all times. Knee socks, tights, stockings, or leggings with crew socks that fully cover the bottom are acceptable.
- Make-up that is noticeable is not permitted at school.
- Nail polish at school: Only light pink and beige may be worn in school.
- **Jewelry** should not be ostentatious or noisy. No multiple earrings allowed.

- **Shoes:** Slides/slippers are not allowed in school. Sneakers or closed shoes are required for PE days.
- **Hair:** Long hair should be held back from falling in a child's face.

Boys' Dress Code

- **Shirts:** Monogrammed white, light blue, or navy polo school shirts.
- **Pants:** Long navy blue or black school pants. *NO multi zipper/pocket, cinched-cuffs, sports/cargo pants, jeggings, jeans, shorts.*
- **Socks:** Crew socks are required.
- **Shoes:** Closed-toe and closed-back shoes are required. *No crocs or sneakers with wheels.*
- Hair: Short haircut, same length all around. No bangs or styled cuts.
- **Bar Mitzvah Boys:** Black hats & jackets are to be worn for Davening. White Oxford shirts are acceptable.
- Accessories are not allowed
